ONTARIO YOUTH APPRENTICESHIP PROGRAMS (OYAP)

STUDENTS PARTICIPATING in the Ontario Youth Apprenticeship Program will gain on-the-job training and experience in a skilled trade while earning credits towards the Ontario Secondary School Diploma (OSSD). Students will also accumulate workplace hours that count towards both secondary school co-op credits and the requirements of an apprenticeship program. They will also have an opportunity to receive Level 1 Apprenticeship in-school training or be eligible to write an exemption test for their Level 1 Apprenticeship.
