7. Presentation regarding Digital Signs

- About Signs (Steve Crawford)
 - Cannot reuse base of current sign as there is no original drawing which City of Burlington would need for permit, therefore would need to remove the whole sign and replace
 - New sign options shared with council 6' off ground to limit vandalization
 - Quote is for one double sided sign \$30,000
- Burlington Signs (Sima Ghassabeh)
 - Suggestion was to keep existing base and retrofit sign to decrease costs
 - 3 options shared with council
 - Quote to keep original base and refurbish sign with LED display \$16,000
 - Sima was asked by council regarding Steves comment about not being able to reuse the base and she stated base was secure and could be reused
 - Quotes for new base were more costly
- New Style Signs (representative not available)
 - One double sided sign using original base \$25,000

8. Financial/Fundraising Report

- Financial Report
 - School Generated Funds approximately \$21 thousand available
