

#### A MINING CITY GOES GREEN (CANADA)

Greater Sudbury in northern Ontario was once one of the largest producers of nickel on the planet, but the 2008 global financial crisis and dwindling reserves led to a sharp decline in output. The area's nickel mining was also notorious for causing air pollution and was even at one time the largest source of sulphur dioxide in the world.

For more than 40 years, however, the city has embraced a very different pursuit: tree-planting. Since 1978, nearly 13,000 volunteers have transformed roughly 3,400 out of 80,000 hectares of barren landscapes—the devastating result of nearly a century's worth of mining and smelting—into thriving greenery. Last July, Prime Minister Justin Trudeau and primatologist Jane Goodall helped plant the project's 10-millionth tree. Thanks to the re-greening effort, Greater Sudbury now boasts some of the cleanest air in Ontario, and there's hope it can inspire other municipalities to follow suit.
