NOT ALL HEROES WEAR CAPES! DRIVER LOSES CONSCIOUSNESS, SEVENTH-GRADER'S HEROIC ACT SAVES SCHOOL BUS FROM CRASHING

"Not all heroes wear capes and this inspiring story of a school kid proves exactly that.

A seventh-grader's quick thinking saved a school bus full of kids from crashing after the driver suddenly lost consciousness.

Though the bus driver, a 40-year-old woman, followed protocol and alerted "home base" that she wasn't well and was going to pull over to allow the transportation department to dispatch someone to provide relief to her, as per Robert D. Livernois, the Warren Consolidated Schools Superintendent.

However, before she could park the bus at the planned destination, she passed out...the boy, who was seated around five rows back, got up from his seat, threw his backpack down and rushed to the front of the bus. Reeves then grabbed the steering wheel and brought the bus to a stop in the middle of the road as the whole bus went into a panic mode.

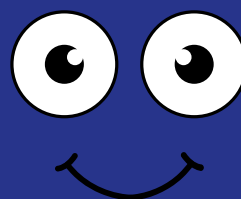
"This young man jumped into action when his school bus driver experienced a medical emergency, bringing the bus to a stop and avoiding what could have been a very tragic accident," Lafferty wrote. "We are very proud of you for your heroic actions!" Warren City Councilman Jonathan Lafferty shared a message of praise for the boy in a Facebook post.
