HAVE CHAIR, WILL TRAVEL!

For 33-year-old American travel blogger Cory Lee, it used to be easier to explore Antarctica than some of the nearby parks and beaches in his home state of Georgia. Using a wheelchair once meant that rugged hiking trails were off-limits, but that's no longer the case.

All-terrain power wheelchairs are now available at state parks in Georgia, as well as in Colorado and Michigan. The wheels and treads on each Action Trackchair allow people with mobility issues to traverse rocky trails, sandy beaches and uneven terrain. They're even powerful enough to make steep uphill climbs.

As Lee told CNN, "It'll open up a whole new world for me and for other wheelchair users."
