What is 2 CDP OYAP

How can I get more information

CDP OYAP is a special School to Career program, which allows secondary school students to begin their post-secondary Child Development Practitioner Apprenticeship while still in secondary school.

- In an apprenticeship, students learn specific theory and skills based on standards set by the Ministry of Training Colleges and Universities.
- In apprenticeship, students ...
 - may earn while they learn.
 - will be taught one on one by a Certified CDP teacher.
 - will be sent to take CDP courses at Mohawk College.
 - and the government will pay approximately 80% of the CDP apprentice's tuition.
- CDP OYAP, allows students to try a college level program before paying to go to College or University.
- Graduating CDP OYAP students still may attend College or University if they have the entrance requirements and pursue a diploma in Early Childhood Education.
