Will I graduate?

- Have you earned 30 credits, including all compulsory credits?
- Have you completed 40 hours of Community Service?
- Have you passed the Literacy Test?
 - If you were unsuccessful on the Literacy Test you must select the following course in grade 12: **OLC4O1**. This course, once earned, will satisfy the Literacy requirement.

Summer School (July)

- 4 week courses are offered:
 - For repeating a failed course (less than 40%)
 - > For earning a reach ahead course

 Registration forms will be available in Student Services in April/May

Summer School (continued):

If you plan on taking a compulsory course in summer school, you must still select it in myBlueprint in your high school planner. Once you are registered for summer school (April), see your guidance counsellor to have it removed and another course added to your planner provide there is space.



Program Eligibility:


- Ontario Secondary School Diploma with a majority of senior credits at the College Preparation (C), University Preparation (U) or University/College Preparation (M) level or Mature Student Status (age 19 or older).
- Grade 12 English: ENG4(C) or ENG4(U)
- Grade 11 or 12 Biology (C) or (U)
- · Grade 11 or 12 Chemistry (C) or (U)
- Grade 12 Mathematics: MCT4(C) Mathematics for College Technology (recommended grade 60% or over) or Grade 12 (U) Mathematics, MHF4 (U) (Advanced Functions) or MCV4(U) (Calculus and Vectors)

Note: All applicants who are offered admission to programs in the Faculty of Applied Science and Engineering Technology will have an English and Mathematics skills assessment. The assessments are used for academic

The course is intended to prepare students for the compulsory Grade 12 university or college preparation course.












Return the sign off sheet to your period 1 teacher by February 28th.

- February 10th myBlueprint will be live and students can begin to submit their course selections.
- February 27th myBlueprint will be shut down for course submissions.
- February 26th February 28thth : Submission of Course Selection to P.1 Teachers

Students will not get equal consideration for elective courses if they are late. Late means after February 28th, 2020.
