


Make sure you have ALL the Requirements

- Group 1- EN/FSL/SS/CWS/GUD/Co-op
- Group 2- PHE/BUS/Art/FSL/Co-op
- Group 3 SNC/TECH/COMP/FSL/Co-op
- 40 hours of Community Service
- Literacy Test (OSSLT): If not successful you will need to be enrolled and complete the OLC Course.





Admission Requirements

Applicants must meet all the requirements below in order to meet minimum program eligibility. Meeting minimum eligibility requirements does not guarantee an offer of admission. Admission decisions will be available via MyHumber, or by email and mail. Admission decisions will not be released by phone.

Admission selection is based on the following 3 requirements:

1. Academic

To be eligible for admission, you must possess the following:

- Ontario Secondary School Diploma (OSSD) or equivalent including these required courses:
 - Grade 12 English (ENG4C or ENG4U or equivalent)
 - Grade 12 Mathematics (MAP4C, MCT4C, MDM4U, MCB4U, MGA4U, MCV4U or MHF4U) or Grade 11 U or M Mathematics (MCR3U or MCF3M)
 - Two Grade 11 or Grade 12 C, M or U courses in addition to those listed above



What do I need to do to achieve my goals for next year?



- Apply online through the Ontario
 University Application Centre (OUAC)
 www.ouac.on.ca
- Require a PIN to apply, which you will receive in early November
- Base Application Fee- available early October
- Additional Program Fee- available early October
- Fees are non- refundable
- Maximum of 3 programs at 1 university
- Once you have submitted your application, if you change a program there will be a fee



- Once the universities receive your academic data, they may issue early conditional offers of admission.
- Each university determines its own criteria for early conditional offers. Early offers are based on a combination of the 3U/M and 4U/M pre requisite courses/grades available at that time.
- Typically, universities make conditional offers of admission from March until May after they receive your grades in February (sem. 1 final) and April (sem. 2 midterm).
- All offers are conditional based off all final grades and any other requirement as outlined by the university.

For applicants currently attending an Ontario high school

101 Criteria

Is this the right application for me?

Answer a few short questions to make sure you are applying with the right undergraduate application.

Do you meet **all** of the following requirements?

- You are taking courses during the day at an Ontario high school (this includes students returning for second semester and graduated students returning to upgrade 1 or more courses).
- You have not, at any point, been out of high school for more than 7 consecutive months.
- You will have received or expect to receive your Ontario Secondary School Diploma (OSSD) with six 4U/M courses at the end of the current year.
- You have not attended a postsecondary institution (college/university/career college).
- You are applying to the first year of an undergraduate degree program or diploma program at an Ontario university.
- You are under 21 years of age.

Start your research with OUInfo!

- A response will be
 - an offer of admission,
 - a refusal or
 - a conditional offer of admission pending the receipt of specific additional information

If you receive an early offer, you will not be required to respond or provide a financial commitment (e.g., residence deposit) of any kind until June 1, 2023. This gives you the opportunity to decide which university to attend if you receive more than one offer.

Applying to your COLLEGE Program

- Certificates require the completion of two semesters (or one year) of study in College
- **Diplomas** require the completion of at least four semesters (or two years) of study.
- Advanced Diplomas- is granted after six semesters (three years) of study.
- **Degrees** require four years of study, as well as U/M level high school prerequisites.
- Collaborative & Joint Degree:-made through a college and partnering university. May earn either one or two credentials-one from the college and/or one from the university.
- CO-OP: include scheduled periods of employment in related industries. Placements are typically paid.
- **Apprenticeship**: enables you to learn a skilled trade on the job, under the supervision of an experienced tradesperson.












Applying to your COLLEGE Program

- Apply through ontariocolleges.ca
- Click the "Create An Account" button
- You can apply to 5 colleges (no more than 3 at one college) Nonrefundable processing fee of \$110.00
- In early October: access to online application open. There is no PIN (personal identification number) required to apply
- Colleges will use both grade 11 and 12 marks. ENG4C is a prerequisite for every program

Applying to your COLLEGE Program

DEADLINE FEBRUARY 1ST, 2023

October: Applications become available for programs starting the following fall

November 1: Colleges may begin sending offers of admission

February 1: **Equal Consideration Date** – apply to **highly competitive programs** on or before this date

May 1: Deadline to confirm offers (colleges may extend offers after this date)

Mid-June: Tuition deposit payment due.

Grades Submissions to Ontario Universities and Colleges

- ALL grade 11 and grade 12 marks are sent electronically to OUAC & OCAS.
- Your admission average will be calculated using your top 6 Grade 12 U/M marks, including prerequisite courses. ENG4U/C is a prerequisite for every program.
- Supplemental Application: some universities will also ask for an application outlining your activities other than academics

Transmission Timeline:

- October- all grade 11 and 12 final marks and courses on your schedule for this year
- November- Semester 1 midterm marks
- February- Semester 1 final marks
- April- Semester 2 midterm marks
- Early July- Semester 2 final marks
- YOU must provide mid-term and final report cards to your guidance counsellor for all courses being taken outside of Halton Catholic District School Board



Advanced Placement Exams for University Transfer Credits

Under "Transfer Credits may be granted by an Ontario University based on AP Exam results" - this means university-level credit for AP work completed in high school (you will have the option to not take that course in university).

AP Capstone students who earn the AP Capstone Diploma can earn up to three credits at the 100 level at certain universities.

All students enrolled in an AP Exam writing course will be called down to a presentation next week.



OTHER!



Courses taken at other School Boards or Private Schools

- **YOU** must provide mid-term and final report cards to your guidance counsellor for all courses being taken outside of Halton Catholic District School Board.
- These marks will be entered manually by your counsellor.


Returning Grade 12s

You may consider returning to BR if...

- Short graduation requirements
- Need more/different courses for post-secondary program
- Improve marks
- Figuring out best pathway option
- Application available on D2L
- Must get counsellor and VP approval to return
- Courses must match pathway plan
- 1 or 2 semesters

Scholarships

Major scholarships and awards are posted to the Student Services D2L page.

Check often; updated frequently!

We subscribe to *The Scholarship Report*.

Many awards require an essay, short answer responses, transcript, references.

Minimum 1 week notice to prepare a transcript (secretary).

Minimum 2 weeks' notice for "referees."

Nominated scholarships: school applications available on D2L; firm deadline; reviewed and selected by committee

OSAP: ONTARIO STUDENT ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

Financial aid program to help pay for college or university

Consists of grants and loans

Amount given depends on various factors

Website: how to apply; online

Need to know programs you are applying to

Can apply before you've accepted an offer

Funds deposited into account/to school after school confirms your enrolment; usually 2 installments
