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AMU 101 Instrumental Music (Band) — This course emphasizes the performance of music at a level that strikes a balance between challenge and skill and is aimed at developing technique, sensitivity, and imagination. Students will participate in creative activities that teach them to listen with understanding.

- AVI 101 Visual Art (Comprehensive) This course offers an overview of visual arts as a foundation for further study. Students will become familiar with the elements and principles of design and the expressive qualities of various materials through working with a range of materials, processes, techniques, and styles.
- AMG2O Guitar—This course develops students' artistic knowledge and skills through the performance of music and the preparation of music productions. Students will perform appropriate works, particularly works in contemporary popular styles. The focus of this course will be on the guitar.
- ADA 201 Drama This course requires students to actively explore dramatic forms and techniques, using their own ideas and concerns as well as sources selected from a wide range of authors, genres, and cultures. Students will assume responsibility for decisions made in the creation and presentation of the drama, and will analyse and reflect on the experience.
- ASM 201 Media Arts—This course enables students to create media art works by exploring new media, emerging technologies such as digital animation, and a variety of traditional art forms such as film, photography, video, and visual arts. Students will develop the skills necessary to create and interpret media art works
- AWQ 301 Photography—This course focuses on studio activities in one or more of the visual arts. Students will create art works that explore a wide range of subject matter, and will evaluate art works.
