

BUSINESS EDUCATION SCHOLARSHIP

Objectives

- A. To recognize Burlington students who have shown leadership and excellence within their communities, among their peers and at their school.
- B. To promote the importance of community involvement in all students.
- C. To increase the level of awareness of the Burlington Chamber of Commerce within the community (especially secondary schools), and the importance of its role in growing the Burlington business community.

Awards Available

A. One award in the amount of \$1,000 is available for all high schools in Burlington (public and separate school boards) to those graduating students who meet the criteria outlined below.

Criteria for Selected Students

- A. A graduating student attending a Canadian university or college.
- B. Demonstrates leadership principles such as participation in the following: **School**
 - Yearbook
 - Student Council
 - Co-operative education programs
 - Leadership programs
 - Student spirit programs

Community

- Involvement and participation in organizations and committees (e.g. Junior Achievement, Rotary, political organizations, youth groups, etc.)
- Volunteer work
- Work-related experience
- C. Demonstration of skills (e.g. problem solving, management, creativity, organization, leadership)
- D. Graduating student attending a Canadian University or College



Requirements from School

- A. Naming and selection process for one award recipient
- B. Notification of award recipient to the Chamber and providing the following scholarship recipient information in order to issue the scholarship:
 - Name of Student Recipient
 - Canadian University or College the student is attending (following graduation)
 - University or College Student ID Number
- C. Agreement to promote Chamber scholarship and student award in social media and through other school channels
- D. Permission from school and/or parent and/or guardian of student to promote scholarship award winner through Chamber communication channels including social media

Requirements from Chamber

- A. Scholarship in an amount approved by the Board of Directors each year issued to one award recipient from each Burlington High School (to be issued through Burlington Chamber Scholarship Fund of the Burlington Community Foundation)
- B. Presentation by the Chamber Board Chair or designate (if requested by school)
