

Grade 12 What's Next

I haven't been accepted yet to an Ontario college...

- Semester 1 Final marks have just been transferred to OUAC and OCAS
- May 1, 2022: Deadline to Confirm Offers of Admission
- After the May 1st deadline, colleges will still accept applications as long as programs are open - you will be processed on a first come first serve basis provided you meet the minimum admission requirements
- check out www.ontariocolleges.ca for open programs.

I haven't been accepted yet to an Ontario university...

- Be aware the universities do not have to respond until May 27, 2022.
- The latest date by which you can expect a response from an Ontario university. This includes:
 - an offer of admission;
 - a refusal; or
 - a deferral, pending the receipt of specific information.
- After May 27th deadline www.ouac.on.ca will show all programs still open at Ontario Universities.
- If you still haven't received an offer of admission you might decide to return to CC to upgrade or go to Thomas Merton - see guidance for options

I've been accepted ...

- What are the deadlines?
 - College
 - May 1, 2022 you must respond to an offer - the last offer accepted is the one that is valid
 - Mid-June earliest date to ask for payment of tuition to secure your spot in your program.
 - Each college sets its own tuition deposit amount and payment deadline.
 - This information will be communicated to you by the college.
 - University
 - May 27, 2022 you shall expect a response from an Ontario University
 - June 1, 2022
The earliest date you may be required to respond to an Ontario university offer of admission and give a financial commitment (e.g., registration deposit, residence deposit, etc.).

I've been accepted...

Questions you need to ask.

- How do I pay?
 - Credit Card, online banking, telephone banking, or cheque
 - What is the processing time for my payment option?
 - Is my deposit non-refundable?
 - When is the rest of my fees due?

I've been accepted...

- But I need money...
 - Apply for OSAP
 - Visit <http://osap.gov.on.ca> and become familiar with procedures
 - Speak to your parents/guardians

I've been accepted...

Questions you need to ask....

- Where do I live?
 - Is residence guaranteed? If not what do I do?
 - What type of room do I want to apply to?
 - What are the costs for the different styles?
 - What is the meal plan?

I've been accepted...

- What courses am I taking?
 - Find out when you can start to select your courses
 - Be aware of your program pre-req's
 - Book an appointment with the College/University - most have a First Year Start up Program

I've been accepted

- Does it matter what happens for the rest of the semester?
 - All offers are conditional - based on final grades
 - Be aware of the conditions of the offer
 - They will rescind the offer
 - Some scholarships will alter based on final grades, you may have to tell the university your grades have gone up.

I've been accepted...

- Will they count summer school in 2022?
 - You usually need to ask (usually in writing) for permission of the college/university to use an upcoming summer school course for admission purposes.
 - It will be your responsibility to make sure the summer school grade is added to your transcript and that a transcript is mailed or emailed to the appropriate institution

I've been accepted...

- How do the schools get my final grades?
 - Electronic transfer in mid July
 - Night school, on-line, independent learning if taken this year - you must bring your final mark to Guidance so that it is entered for the final transfer of grades

I've been accepted...

- What if I have an IEP?
 - None of your information is transferred to the college or university. You must disclose to the college or university if you would like accommodations.
 - It is to your advantage to pass this information on to the school you are attending in the summer prior to attending.
 - It is your responsibility to have a copy of your current assessment to provide to the institution.

 - Some universities will offer a deferral however you must accept the offer prior to asking for a deferral. Always check with the university prior to making that final decision.
