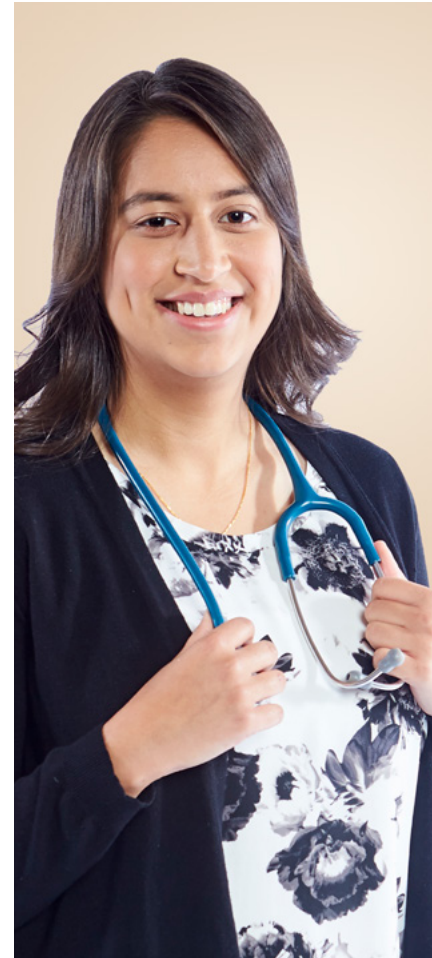

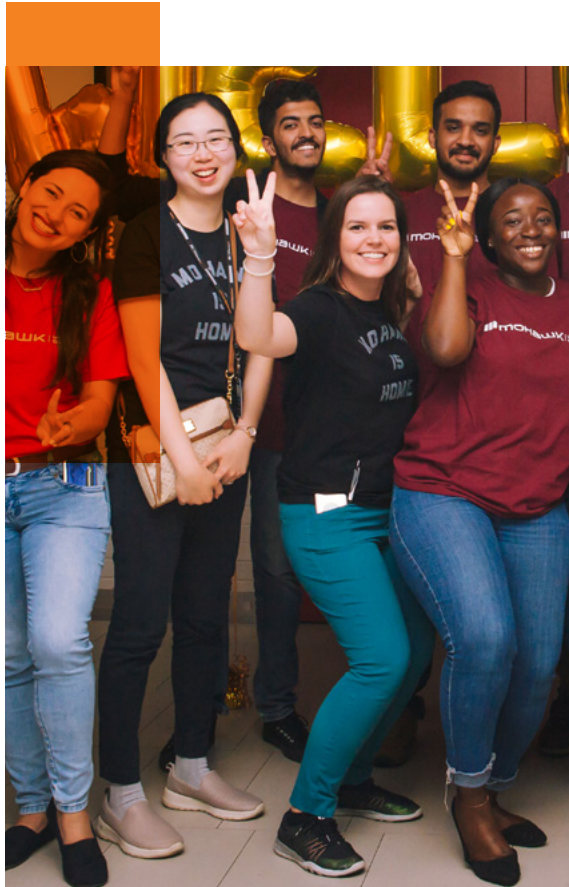

Ready to apply? Domestic or Canadian applicants apply through the Ontario College Application System at [ontariocolleges.ca](https://ontariocolleges.ca). You are considered a Domestic applicant if you are a Canadian citizen or a permanent resident that resides inside or outside of Canada.

Pay special attention to the deadlines for competitive programs, indicated with **C** beside the program name. These programs have more qualified applicants than there are spaces. To be considered on an equal basis with all other applicants you must apply for these programs before the “equal consideration date”. Refer to the applicant timeline below for important dates.
