

Tips for Selecting Courses for Grade 10

Quick Reference Sheet

Compulsory Courses for Grade 11: Select 3 Compulsories

English: ENG 3U (University)

ENG 3C (College)

ENG 3E (Workplace--if recommended by teacher)

NBE 3U (Indigenous Voices) This course is an alternative to the ENG 3U and fulfills the grade 11 English requirement

Math: MCR 3U (University)

MCF 3M (Mixed—this course allows students an opportunity to move from the COLLEGE to UNIVERSITY stream. Speak to your Math teacher or Guidance Counsellor to see if this is a good option for you)

MBF 3C (College)

MEL 3E (Workplace-if recommended by teacher)

Religion: HRF 3M (University)

HRF 3O (College)

HRT 3MF (For students in Extended French Program)

Students must ensure they have the Grade 10 PREREQUISITE for any Grade 11 courses they are selecting

Selecting Levels

- **UNIVERSITY OR MIXED:** (courses with 'U' or 'M' in the course code eg. ENG 3U or AMU 3M) Students planning to attend UNIVERSITY should be choosing courses mostly at this level to prepare for Grade 12, although a mixture of level is still common as students are exploring Pathways. Refer to myBlueprint.ca and ElectronicInfo.ca for more information.
- **COLLEGE OR OPEN:** (courses with 'C' or 'O' in the course code eg. ENG 3C or CHT 3O) Students planning to attend COLLEGE should be choosing courses at this level.
- **WORKPLACE/LOCALLY DEVELOPED** (course with 'O' or 'E' in the course code eg. ENG 3E or HPC 3O) Students planning to move onto directly to the workplace after graduation from high school.

Elective Courses for Grade 11: Select 5 Electives

Elective courses provide students with an opportunity to explore an **area of interest or a strength**. The courses and course descriptions being offered for Grade 11 students will be listed on myBlueprint.ca. Make sure to select 5 electives in addition to your **3 compulsories**.

Plan ahead if possible and take and ensure you take the Grade 11 prerequisite courses for any Grade 12 courses you might want to take (Check prerequisites on myBlueprint.ca or speak to your Counsellor).

Important Reminders:

- Grade 10 students are not permitted to have spares or free periods. They must have 8 credits completed for the year (3 compulsory credits and 5 elective credits).
- All students must ensure they take an Art and Phys. Ed. credit and a credit from Groups 1, 2 and 3 (Refer to myBlueprint) during Grade 9-12.
- If you are planning to take summer school, the registrations will be announced in late April or early May so pay attention to announcements.
- Choose courses and levels *WISELY*. Speak to your teacher and consider their recommendations or come inquire with your Counsellor.
- There are **NO COURSE CHANGES** after the Course Verification Deadline of April 30,
