

# Tips for Selecting Courses for Grade 11

## Quick Reference Sheet

### Compulsory Courses for Grade 12: Select 2 Compulsories

**English:** ENG 4U (University)

ENG 4C (College)

ENG 4E (Essential/Workplace--if recommended by teacher)

**Religion:** HRE 4M (University)

HRE 4O (College)

HSE 4M (Social Justice – Mixed Level)

\*\*\*Students must ensure they have the Grade 11 PREREQUISITES for any Grade 12 courses they are selecting\*\*\*

### Selecting Levels

- **UNIVERSITY OR MIXED:** (courses with 'U' or 'M' in the course code eg. ENG 4U or AMG 4M) Students planning to attend UNIVERSITY should be choosing courses mostly at this level. All university programs require 6 Grade 12 4U or 4M level courses, including ENG 4U. Refer to myBlueprint.ca and electronicinfo.ca for more information.
- **COLLEGE OR OPEN:** (courses with 'C' or 'O' in the course code eg. ENG 4C or AMG 4M) Students planning to attend COLLEGE should be choosing courses at this level.
- **WORKPLACE/LOCALLY DEVELOPED** (course with 'O' or 'E' in the course code eg. ENG 4E or HPC PPL 4O) Students planning to move onto directly to the workplace after graduation from high school.

### Elective Courses for Grade 11: Select 6 Electives

Elective courses provide students with an opportunity to explore an **area of interest or a strength**. The courses and course descriptions being offered for Grade 12 students will be listed on myBlueprint.ca. Make sure to select **6 electives** in addition to your **2 compulsories**.

\*\*\*Important Note: All grade 12s planning to attend university must have 6 Grade 12 University or Mixed level courses. Ensure you have at least **6 4 U/M level courses on your timetable which include any prerequisite courses required for your program.**

#### Important Reminders:

- Grade 12 students are permitted to have up to 2 spares in their grade 12 year but are encouraged to take a 7<sup>th</sup> course as a buffer (if one mark is not high enough, they have an alternate mark for their 6 courses for university and college application).
- All students must ensure they have taken an Art and Phys. Ed. credit and a credit from Groups 1, 2 and 3 (Refer to myBlueprint) during Grade 9-12).
- Students must ensure they have all prerequisite courses prior to taking a grade 12 course.
- Choose courses and levels *WISELY*. Speak to your teacher and consider their recommendations or come inquire with your Counsellor.
- There are **NO COURSE CHANGES** after the Course Verification Deadline of April 30,

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
