CHRIST THE KING CATHOLIC SCHOOL COUNCIL ELECTION PROCEDURES

A "School Councils" regulation under the *Education Act*, which came into effect in December 2000, sets out specific requirements regarding the composition of School Councils and election processes. It is expected that the obligations set out in the regulations are observed each year. One of the requirements of the regulation is that the School Council elections must take place within the first 30 days of each school year.

At Christ the King Catholic Secondary School, we invite you to consider nominating yourself, or another parent candidate, by Thursday September 16th, 2021. The receipt of the nomination will be confirmed in writing.

Should we receive more than 20 nominations (as per our bylaws), we will hold an election on September 27th. If we receive 20 nominations or less and all candidates fulfil the requirements

as outlined in the new regulation, you will be informed of the membership. The date of the first ***virtual meeting*** is scheduled for Tuesday October 5th, 2021.

We look forward to working closely with the new Christ the King Catholic School Council, and to a fulfilling and productive 2021 - 2022 school year!
