<p>Principal's Update: Kevin Wong</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● new Vice Principal started last week - Mrs. Morrow</li> <li>● Ms. Monroe is on a leave of absence</li> <li>● Grade 10 Literacy Test will be on March 22; after school literacy program runs on Wednesdays to help students prepare for the literacy test</li> <li>● GHAC Swim Event; one swimmer qualified for OFSAA in 50m breaststroke and 100m freestyle events</li> <li>● Me-to-We Club</li> <li>● Career Fair February 28 for Grade 10 students; 9:30-11am; 26 community members coming in representing a variety of careers; students have an opportunity to browse and ask questions</li> <li>● Grade 7 day in April for students from elementary feeder schools</li> </ul>
<p>Teacher Rep Update: Anna Carambia, Department Head of Student Services</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● option sheet presentations have started with grade 11 classes; will work on Grade 10 presentations by the end of this week and grade 9 presentations next week; option sheets are due by March 7; students cannot enter courses after March Break; guidance counselors are available to help with changes; summer school applications will be in April</li> <li>● question: will there be a curriculum night in second semester? No; will possibly reorganize curriculum night to allow parents to learn about each of the subjects as opposed to just visiting with first semester teachers</li> <li>● EQAO - some changes have been made to the accommodations allowed for students e.g., extra time is now permitted for all students (not just students with an IEP)</li> </ul>
