

If you are unable to see a doctor before the February 6, 2020 suspension date, please visit the Halton Region Health Department **walk-in** clinics at Queen Elizabeth Park Community and Cultural Centre, 2302 Bridge Road, Oakville, L6L 3L5 during the following dates and times:

Saturday, February 1, 2020: 9 a.m.-3:30 p.m.

Monday, February 3, 2020: 9 a.m.–3:30 p.m.

Tuesday, February 4, 2020: 9 a.m.-3:30 p.m.

Wednesday, February 5, 2020: 9 a.m.-3:30 p.m.

Please arrive early. No appointment is needed, however you must be registered at the clinic by 3:30 p.m. to be seen by a nurse.

Clinic dates will also occur on and after the suspension date on:

Thursday, February 6, 2020: 9 a.m.–3:30 p.m.

Friday, February 7, 2020: 9 a.m.–3:30 p.m.
