

An Important Message for the St. Ignatius of Loyola Catholic Secondary School Community

Dear Parents and Guardians,

You are receiving this email because you have one or more children enrolled at St. Ignatius of Loyola Catholic Secondary School in Oakville. We are writing to let you know that we were informed today (Tuesday, September 22, 2020) that a member of the St. Ignatius of Loyola community has tested positive for COVID-19.

Halton Public Health have completed their review and have confirmed that there is no exposure risk to students or staff at school. The individual has been directed by Public Health to self-isolate for 14 days. Due to privacy legislation, no additional information will be provided.

While we know that the news of a positive case of COVID-19 in our community is always a concern, it is an important reminder to all of us to be especially vigilant in checking for signs of symptoms of COVID-19.

Students and staff are reminded that a daily self-assessment must be completed each day before entering our school. As always, the health and safety of our students, staff and families is our highest priority, and we will continue to take direction from Halton Region Public Health as they monitor the situation and ensure all protocols are in place and followed.
