Good Afternoon Loyola Families,

Thank you for another great week of learning and collaboration. As we look towards next week we wanted to share a few reminders and updates with you.

Daily Self-Screening:

Parents and guardians are reminded to monitor for signs and symptoms of COVID-19 in your children and to complete the <u>COVID-19 Self-Assessment Tool for Schools</u> each morning before sending your children to school.

Attendance:

Teachers take attendance daily and need to have it submitted by 9:00 am for the first period of the day and 2:05 for the second period of the day. If a student arrives after this time they will be marked absent. When the call goes home <u>it is the responsibility of the parent and student</u> to rectify the absence. If a student is having technical difficulties they need to notify their teacher immediately. They will still be marked absent and parents are expected to report the attendance through the Attendance app. <u>Ongoing technical issues do not excuse</u> attendance. Reach out to your teacher if you need help and support to ensure you are in class on time and in the correct location (D2L, Teams, Google classroom) to be marked present and participate in the class.

Teachers print out attendance reports that track entry and exit times in D2L, Teams or Google classroom. If your child is frequently logging in and out during class time and missing portions of the class, they will be marked absent. Students are expected to be online and participating actively during class time.

If a student is scheduled to be physically in the building and they choose to work online for the day, they will be marked absent. Our attendance records need to indicate who is physically present to ensure safety in the event of emergencies or for contact tracing.

You are able to review your child's attendance on <u>SIS</u>. Please contact their VP if there are any questions.
