Students should follow these steps:

- 1. Watch the posted presentation that relates to the grade they will be entering
- 2. Review the Course Selection Guide that lists all the course offerings. This can be found on Loyola's main homepage under Students or on the Student Services D2L page.
- 3. Use the course codes listed on the Course Selection Guide as reference when adding courses into the High School Planner in My Blueprint
- 4. Check the Graduation Indicator in My Blueprint for any missing graduation requirements
- 5. Once the plan is submitted changes can not be done in My Blueprint. Contact a guidance counsellor for more direction
- 6. My Blueprint will send the parent/guardian an email to approve the plan. Course submissions will not be officially submitted until the plan has been approved. Parents/guardians please check your emails.
- 7. If after reviewing the presentations and students have questions, they can attend a Q & A session. Dates and times will be posted in the Student Services D2L page
