Students who are enrolled in two-credit co-operative education will conclude their programs on August 6, 2021.

Summer students enrolled in a co-op course will be receiving start-up information from their instructors through their Google email.
- Parents are also encouraged to update their contact information with their child's home school to receive email communications from the Thomas Merton Centre.
