## Safe and Inclusive Plan – St. Ignatius of Loyola Catholic Secondary School 2024-2025

**Overall Goal:** To create a positive school climate that supports a safe learning and teaching environment in which every student can reach their God given potential. All pathways are honoured and supported to further this goal. Students feel invested in the school and can see themselves and their experiences represented in the curriculum and school environment. ## School Specific Goal(s):

- 1. Strive to address student engagement through varied pathways, differentiated learning in the classroom, experiential and equitable learning opportunities, culturally relevant and responsive pedagogy and through varied leadership and participation-based initiatives during the school day and year.
- 2. While focusing on prevention and working with families and the community, strive to ensure that a progressive discipline approach is utilized and is considerate of the varied mitigating factors which our students are faced with and experience.
- 3. Establish clear and consistent reporting procedures for matters that affect the safety and security of the school and the moral tone of the school environment.
- 4. Provide relevant, timely and focused training and education to students, staff and parents on anti black racism, ableism, homophobia, transphobia, anti-Asian racism, Islamophobia.
- Solicit student voice and feedback through equity-based school teams, clubs and committees to ensure Loyola's students feel safe, valued, represented and included (eg., GSA, BSA, Indigenous Advocacy Committee, Mental Health Champions, Social Justice Committee, Safe Schools Team, Hawk Eye Leadership / Peer Mentorship Program).
