### TERMS AND CONDITIONS

**Scholarship/Award specifics:** The Ron McDermott Vocational Studies Award is available annually through the Rotary Club Burlington Lakeshore Charitable Foundation.

**One award of \$2,500** in memory of Ron McDermott is directed to a student pursuing post-secondary **vocational training** through a recognized institution or program such as a community college, private vocational school, university, apprenticeship or trade program. The award is to be used for tuition/enrolment fees, program/trades supplies or training costs.

This award is in memory of **Ron McDermott**, an active member of the Rotary Club of Burlington Lakeshore (RCBL) and president in 1987-88. Ron believed in hard work, the value of professions and vocations, and the importance of education as one means of achieving higher vocational goals.

**Closing date:** Completed application form and supporting documents (as detailed below) must be sent in PDF format to [RotaryCBLAwards@gmail.com](mailto:RotaryCBLAwards@gmail.com) -- no later than **June 8, 2020**.

Applications will be screened by the Awards Sub Committee and final selection will be made through an interview process.

#### To be eligible you must:

- Be a grade 12 graduate or mature student or equivalent.
- Be committed to pursuing vocational training / skilled trades training with a specific career focus (i.e. not general studies) in the year after receiving the award.
- Demonstrate a reasonable level of past academic achievement.
- Demonstrate strength of character, honesty, diligence and reliability.
- Demonstrate kindness through a volunteer capacity.
- Proof of acceptance/payment may be required to receive award payment.
- Particular consideration will be given to greater Burlington area students with financial need, and to mature students who have overcome personal challenges in completing high school requirements.

## ADDITIONAL DOCUMENTS

**In addition to the application form, please include the following documents as part of the total application package:**

- A letter (500 word max.) detailing your academic journey, your career goals and planned studies, your work and community activities, how the Award would impact your ability to achieve your career goals, and outlining your family/community support and financial resources.
- Two reference letters from relevant, non-family members (e.g. teacher, employer, volunteer work associate) attesting to academic journey, expanding upon work ethic and volunteer contributions.
- A transcript of the last available secondary school courses taken and grades received.
- Relevant portfolio materials, newspaper clippings, and award certificates.
- Provide a simple budget outlining your education program costs and funding sources.
- If available, include a letter from a former teacher
