Demonstrate good academic performance, but not necessarily be considered “academically elite.” Demonstrate a strong work ethic, commitment to their studies and service to others. Has overcome obstacles to successfully graduate from secondary school. Special consideration may be given to students who have faced financial barriers

<p>The recipient is to be chosen by an Awards Selection Committee established by the RTOERO. To be considered, students must submit the following:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Completed application form 2. A letter of support from 1. a guidance counsellor, student success teacher OR special education teacher AND 2. a current or previous secondary school teacher of the applicant. 3. A one-to-two-page letter from the student, outlining: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. their academic and career goals; b. how they have provided service to others; c. how they have overcome a personal obstacle in their academic career; d. and how this award will help them. 4. A copy of their most recent credit counselling summary or transcript. 5. Proof of acceptance to a post-secondary program or apprenticeship to receive the cheque.
