# Principal's Report: Mr. Roberts

## • Student Award Night

- Traditionally, Awards Night is held in September, in-person with low attendance.
- This year, honor-rolls will be presented during school, by grade. It will also be posted on the website (with permission)
- The following day, subject award winners will be presented
- Why?
  - Delayed results due to new platform from the board (Power School)
  - Low attendance to awards night in the past
  - 650 students on the honor roll this year. School cannot accommodate
  - It would be a lot of money and a lot of work to plan multiple ceremonies
- Mr.Roberts to look into video streaming awards for parents

## • Bathroom Update

- Noticeable improvement
- Interior lock on the door was investigated and it is a non-issue. The inside lock does not lock the door
- Board has chosen our school to participate in a washroom accessibility audit
- School will receive \$230,000 grant to make it more wheelchair accessible
- Because of this, all washroom doors will have magnets and be open at all time



- 3 new lunchroom supervisors have been hired to monitor washrooms and stairwells
- Warnings have been issued to students vaping in the school that next time it will go to municipality and there will be a \$300 fine
- Addiction nurse is available to students that suffer from addiction

### • Cafeteria Update

- Subway would not be able to accommodate the quantity needed
- Students prefer hot food
- Meeting/tour of kitchen has been schedule for a new catering company
- No food trucks permit is too difficult and expensive for vendors

### Black Student Union

- First meeting last Friday night
- 3 teachers and a community partner have signed on to help facilitate
- 12-14 students have come to participate
- Main focus is how to celebrate black culture

### • Alternative Areas for lunch

- Request for an alternative area for students that would like a quiet space for lunch
- Cafeteria is not necessarily full, it's just very loud
- Some students enjoy spending lunch in the stairwell so long as they clean up after themselves and behave, it is allowed. (May become an issue when the cold weather comes)
- These areas are monitored by supervisors
- Wellness room is not for eating and is small
- Library does not allow food
