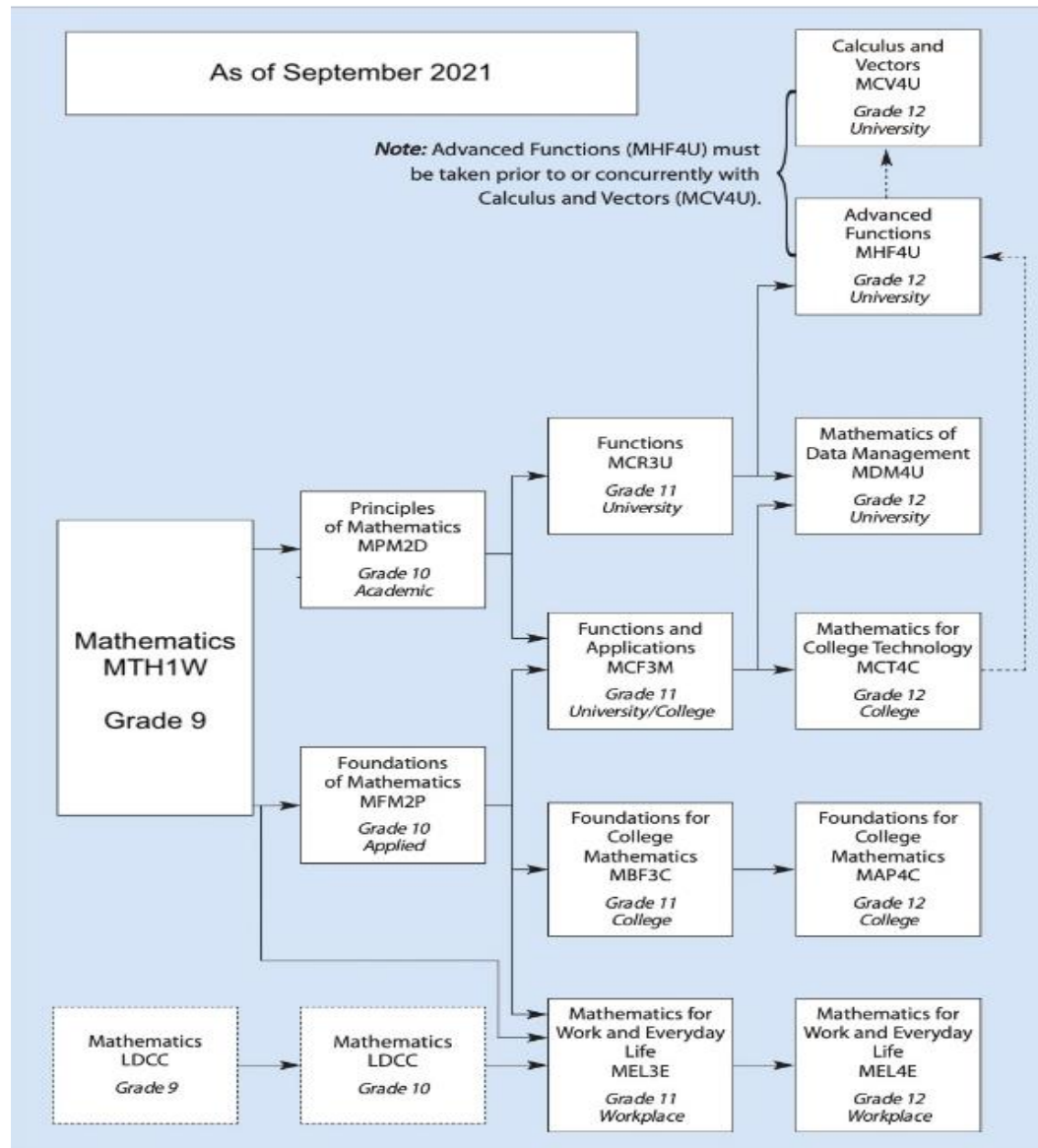

# SUMMER SCHOOL (JULY)

- ▶ Most summer school courses are 4 weeks in length (exception - 2 credit co-op). Upgrading a mark will also require 4 weeks.
- ▶ REGISTER through myBlueprint in April/May.
- ▶ If you are sure that you will take summer school and plan to take CHV20/GLC20 (Civics/Careers), you can leave that course off your course selection in myBlueprint and select another course in its place.



# TRANSCRIPT RULES

- ▶ **Grade 9 & 10 courses:** only successful attempts of courses are recorded.
- ▶ **Grade 11 & 12 courses:** all attempts of courses (including failures) are recorded
- ▶ **Grade 12 student:** if a grade 12 student drops a course before the mid-term date this will NOT be recorded on the student transcript.
- ▶ **No spares for students in grades 9-11.**
- ▶ **Grade 12 students must carry at least 3 courses per semester.**

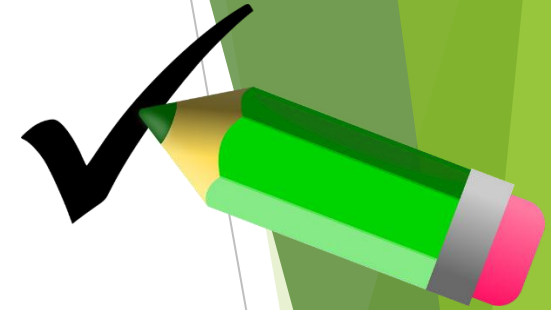

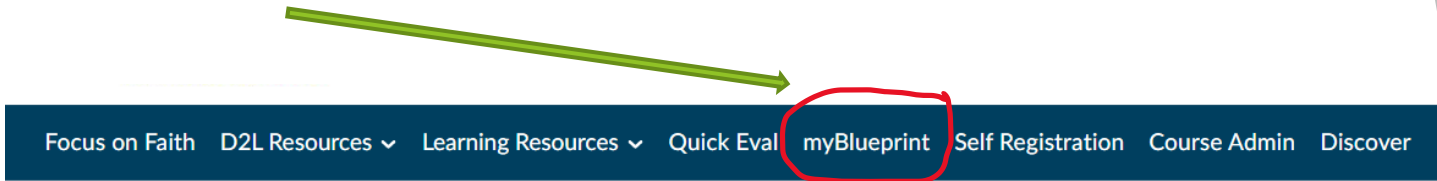

## Description

This course emphasizes the consolidation of the reading, communication, and critical and creative thinking skills necessary for success in academic and daily life. Students will analyse a range of challenging literary texts from various periods, countries, and cultures; informational and graphic texts; and create oral, written, and media texts in a variety of forms. An important focus will be on using academic language coherently and confidently, selecting the reading strategies best suited to particular texts and particular purposes for reading, and developing greater control in writing. The course is intended for preparing students for university, college, or the workplace. Students transferring moving from one destination to another (e.g., college to university or workplace to college) must successfully complete a transfer process.

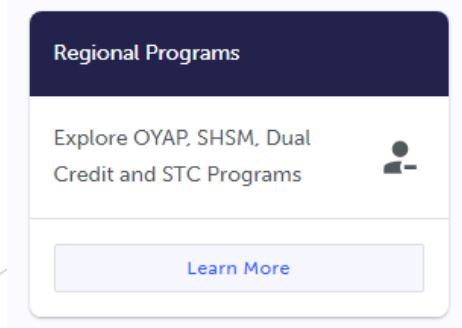
