

SUMMER SCHOOL (JULY)

- Most summer school courses are 4 weeks in length (exception - 2 credit co-op). Upgrading a mark will also require 4 weeks.
- REGISTER through myBlueprint in April/May.
- If you are sure that you will take summer school and plan to take CHV2O/GLC2O (Civics/Careers), you can leave that course off your course selection in myBlueprint and select another course in its place.





TRANSCRIPT RULES

- ► Grade 9 & 10 courses: only successful attempts of courses are recorded.
- ► Grade 11 & 12 courses: all attempts of courses (including failures) are recorded
- ► Grade 12 student: if a grade 12 student drops a course before the mid-term date this will NOT be recorded on the student transcript.
- ► No spares for students in grades 9-11.
- ► Grade 12 students must carry at least 3 courses per semester.
