Daily Schedule:



Lates:

Students are expected to arrive at school and classes on time. For period one, students must be in class for opening exercises at 8:20 AM.

When a student reaches four lates in a course, the teacher will contact home and have a discussion with the parents/guardians. If the lates continue, the student will be sent to the attendance office to speak with a Vice Principal. Persistent lates will result in progressive discipline.

Sign-Outs:

When a student is signed out of school by a parent or guardian, they must leave school property. They are not allowed to be signed out to study in the library or cafeteria or watch a school sports team.

Uniform:

Students are reminded that they are expected to be in **full uniform in all areas of the building.** The only items that are part of our uniform are:



The only approved hoodie is the one pictured above and sold at McCarthy's. **SHSM, team, club and spirit wear is not part of our uniform.** Track pants are not part of the uniform and should not be worn in the building at any time. Students are reminded that hats and hoods are not to be worn in the building at any time.

Shoes must be closed toe and closed back. Backless slippers, crocs, and slides are not permitted footwear.

Washrooms:

As we continue to work to improve accessibility in our washrooms, students are reminded:

- Students are not to congregate in washrooms.
- Students are not to sit on the floor or eat in washrooms
- There should only be one student in a stall at all times
- Backpacks are not permitted in the washroom

Students that are unable to adhere to these expectations will face progressive discipline.
