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

### Valedictorian

- Nomination forms will be released in the middle of April. You cannot nominate yourself!
- Nominees must be eligible; nominations will verified & candidates confirmed

### Beginning of May:

- Nominees will each give a 2 minute speech (why you should vote for me)
- Online voting for preferred candidate (4 days for this)
- Person who receives the most votes is the Valedictorian; 2nd most votes is the Salutatorian (gives the welcome)
- The valedictorian and salutatorian will begin working on their speeches and meet with Ms. Power by the 3rd week of May

#### Brunch/Rehearsal and Ceremony

- Brunch, Rehearsal and Ceremony all taking place on Tuesday June 23, 2020
- It is important to follow all the info that is coming regarding this day. Keep an eye on the website.
- Rehearsal is imperative to attend. Everyone has a responsibility to be at the rehearsal the morning of June 23rd if they want to walk down the aisle at Grad.
- Ceremony is a very solemn event, and everyone wants it to run as smoothly as possible. At the
  rehearsal we will go over a lot of information items including seating arrangements, how the
