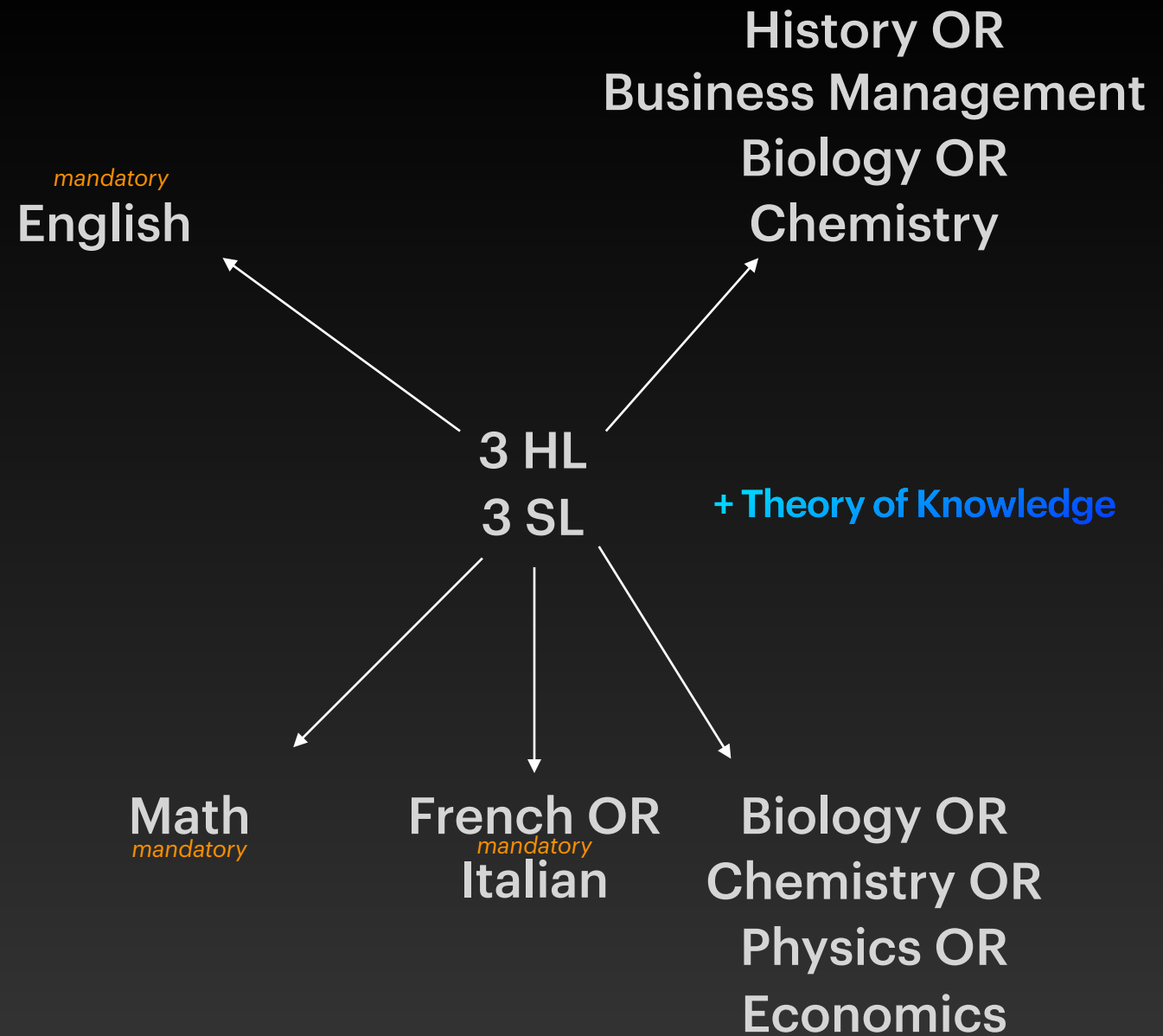

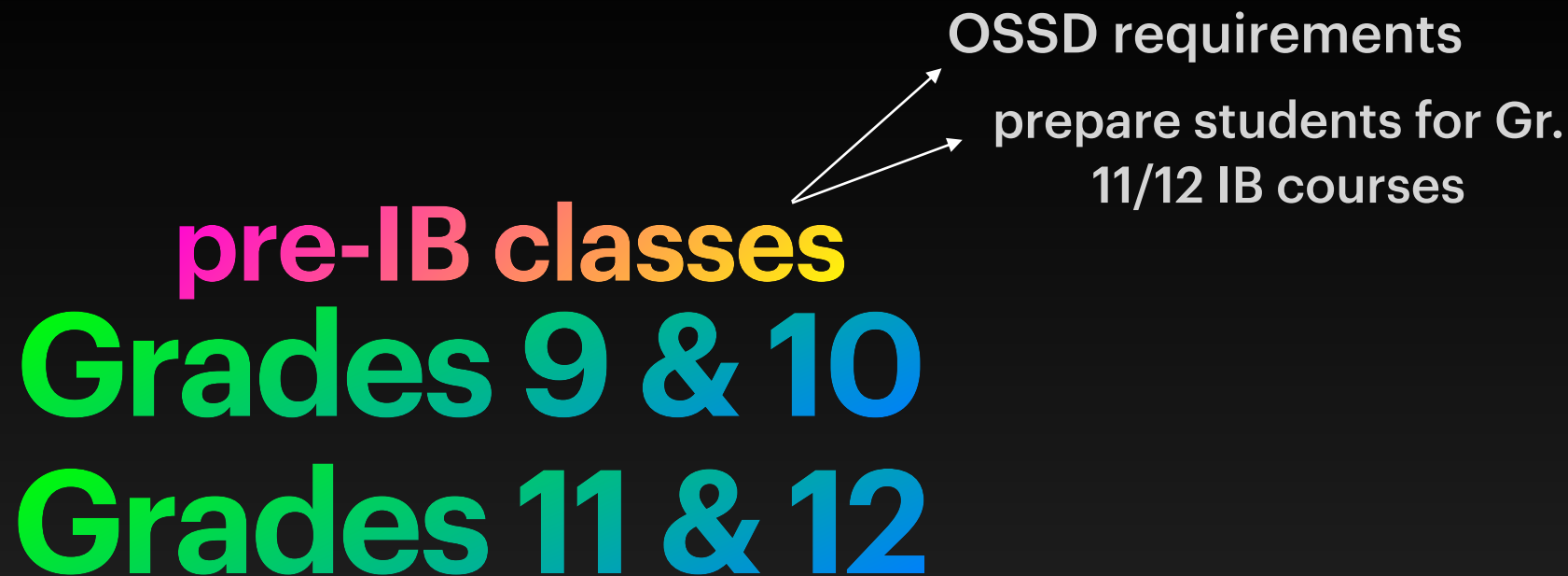

# What do you need to graduate?

In order to obtain your Ontario Secondary School Diploma (**O.S.S.D**) you need:

4 credits in English (1 credit per grade)

3 credits in mathematics (1 credit at the senior level)

2 credits in science

1 credit in Canadian History

1 credit in Canadian Geography

1 credit in the arts

1 credit in health and physical education

1 credit in French as a second language

.5 credit in career studies

.5 credit in civics

# What do you need to graduate?

**PLUS one credit from each of the following groups:**

**Group 1:** Additional credit in English, or French as a second language, or other international language, or Social Sciences and the Humanities, or Canadian and World Studies, or Guidance & Career Education or Coop

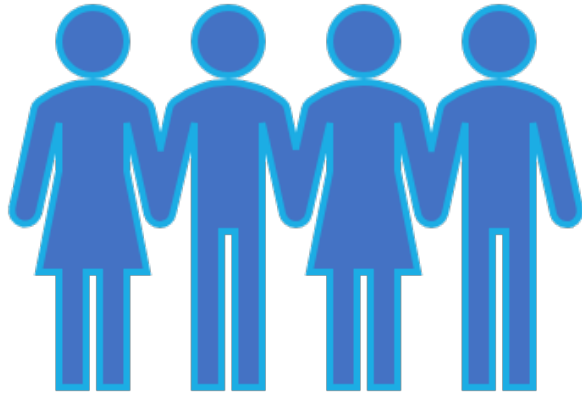
**Group 2:** Additional credit in Health and Physical Education, or the Arts, or Business Studies, or French as a second language or Coop

**Group 3:** Additional credit in senior level science, or Technological education, or French as a second language or computer studies or Coop


# eLearning - 2 courses

All students in Ontario are required to complete 2 online eLearning courses.

In the Grade 12 column of the MyBlueprint planner you will be able to opt out of the eLearning Requirement.

This option will ONLY be there for people who have the option - if you don't see it you have either already completed the requirement or you have already opted out on paper.

Even though you see the opt out option under «courses», it does not count as a course!!

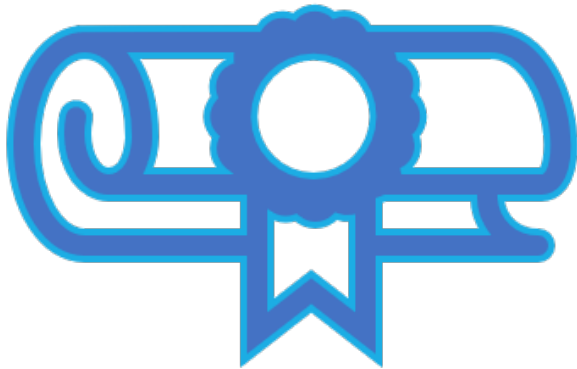

# CAS & EE

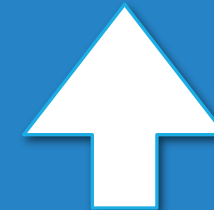

# Planning Considerations

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Research university/college programs and their course requirements using **myBlueprint** or **OntarioUniversitiesInfo** **before you choose your courses**. Every university program will have different requirements.

For example, Engineering programs usually require Physics, Chemistry, and Math, while Health Science programs require Biology, Chemistry, and Math. *All programs require English!*

You should also check the admission requirements on the university's website. In particular, check to see if repeated/upgrade courses are accepted.

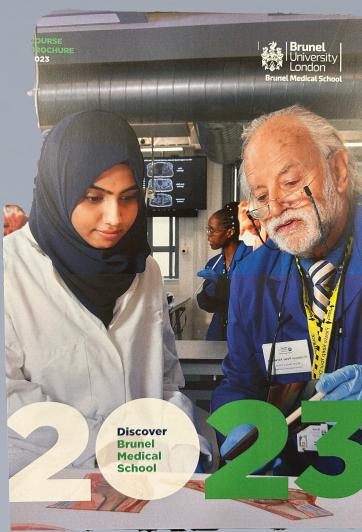
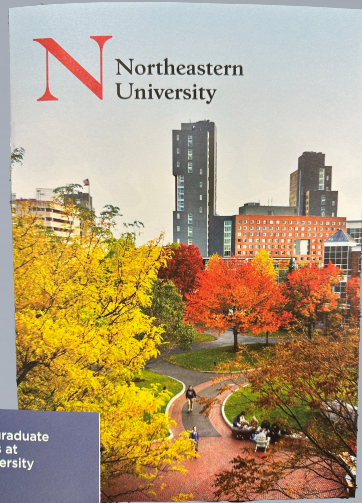

Universities **OUTSIDE** of Ontario: it is the student's responsibility to research and apply. Be aware of application deadlines. Usually earlier than Ontario ones.



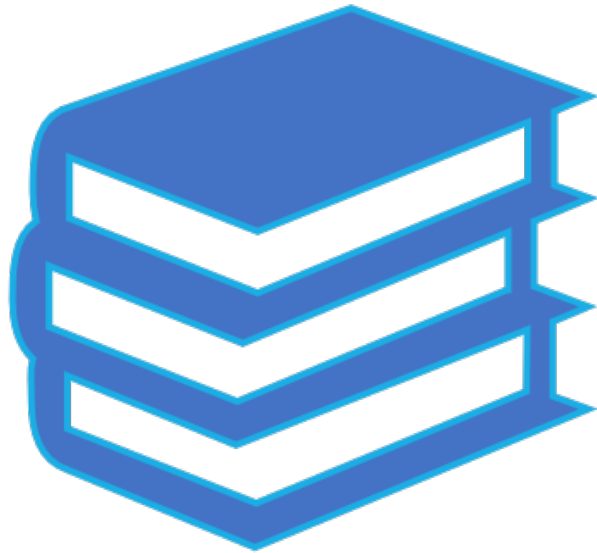

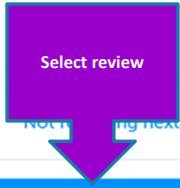
