## What do you need to graduate?

In order to obtain your Ontario Secondary School Diploma (O.S.S.D) you need:

## 18 Compulsory Credits:

4 credits in English (1 credit per grade)
3 credits in mathematics (1 credit at the senior level)
2 credits in science
1 credit in Canadian History
1 credit in Canadian Geography
1 credit in the arts
1 credit in health and physical education
1 credit in French as a second language
.5 credit in career studies
. 5 credit in civics

## What do you need to graduate?

## PLUS one credit from each of the following groups:

Group 1: Additional credit in English, or French as a second language, or other international language, or Social Sciences and the Humanities, or Canadian and World Studies, or Guidance \& Career Education or Coop

Group 2: Additional credit in Health and Physical Education, or the Arts, or Business Studies, or French as a second language or Coop

Group 3: Additional credit in senior level science, or Technological education, or French as a second language or computer studies or Coop

## Community Involvement (40 hours)

Pick up a form in Student Services, the IB Office, or visit the STA website for a form to record the details of your involvement - dates, hours completed and organization/ contact names, signatures, and phone numbers. Alternatively, you can submit a letter from the organization (on letterhead) that outlines the details of your involvement. Return all forms to the IB office.

## eLearning - 2 courses

All students in Ontario are required to complete 2 online eLearning courses.

In the Grade 12 column of the MyBlueprint planner you will be able to opt out of the eLearning Requirement.

This option will ONLY be there for people who have the option - if you don't see it you have either already completed the requirement or you have already opted out on paper.

Even though you see the opt out option under «courses», it does not count as a course!!


## Ontario Student Transcript

## Will I earn my IB Diploma?

You must complete an IB course in each Group ( 6 IB exams, $3 \mathrm{HL} \& 3 \mathrm{SL}$ ).You must complete your CAS requirements.

You must complete your Extended Essay.

You must complete Theory of Knowledge.

## CAS \& EE

CAS (Creativity, Activity, and Service) must be ongoing throughout the two years of the IBDP.

You should continue to engage in CAS experiences throughout the summer and record your evidence and reflections in ManageBac.

Your Extended Essay timeline and due dates are posted to ManageBac.

Keep in touch with your EE mentor as your work through this assignment!

In addition to verifying these requirements, you should be researching your chosen post-secondary path to see if there are pre-requisite courses - PATHWAYS.

## Planning Considerations

Research university/college programs and their course requirements using myBlueprint or OntarioUniversitiesInfo before you choose your courses. Every university program will have different requirements.

For example, Engineering programs usually require Physics, Chemistry, and Math, while Health Science programs require Biology, Chemistry, and Math. All programs require English!
You should also check the admission requirements on the university's website. In particular, check to see if repeated/ upgrade courses are accepted.

Planning to attend a university/college in the U.S? You may need to write your SATs. Plan early. Find a testing facility. Some universities may not need SAT scores if you have your IB diploma. Begin your research now!

An important focus will be on using academic language coherently and confidently, selecting the reading strategies best suited to particular texts and particular purposes for reading, and developing greater control in writing. The course is intended to prepare students for university, college, or the workplace. Students considering moving from one destination to another (e.g., college to university; workplace to college) must successfully complete a transfer course.
