Additional credit in Health and Physical Education, or the Arts, or Business Studies, or French as a second language or Coop

Group 3:

Additional credit in senior level science, or Technological education, or French as a second language or computer studies or Coop

Community Involvement (40 hours)

Pick up a form in Student Services, the IB Office, or visit the STA website for a form to record the details of your involvement – dates, hours completed and organization/ contact names, signatures, and phone numbers.

Alternatively, you can submit a letter from the organization (on letterhead) that outlines the details of your involvement.

eLearning Requirement

All students in Ontario are required to complete **2 online learning courses**. However, IB courses are **not** available online.

In the Grade 12 column of the MyBlueprint planner you will be able to opt out of the online learning requirement. This option will only be there for people who have the option - if you don't see it, you already completed the requirement, or you already opted out on paper.

Even though you see the opt out option under «courses», it does not count as a course!!

Planning Considerations

Research university/college programs and their course requirements using **myBlueprint** or **OntarioUniversitiesInfo before you choose your courses**.

Every university program will have different requirements.

For example, Engineering programs usually require Physics, Chemistry, and Math, while Health Science programs require Biology, Chemistry, and Math. All programs require English!

You should also check the admission requirements on the university and college website. In particular, check to see if repeated/ upgrade courses are accepted.

- You will not be considered for the IB Certificate Program if you have not successfully earned all grade 9 and 10 pre-IB credits.
- Students in the IB Certificate Program, must enroll in Grade 11 Religion AND a minimum of three
 (3) IB courses with a minimum of two (2) courses at the HL Level (regardless of entry year).
 - □ IB courses and religion will take priority in scheduling over other elective courses
 - □ IB Certificate students are **not eligible** to complete ToK, CAS or EE
 - □ You are responsible to making sure you have chosen what you need to complete your Certificate
- ** IB Courses and religion will take priority in scheduling over other Ontario credit courses
- ** IB Certificate fees are non-refundable, are based on course selections and are paid in full in grade 11.

SHSM Programs

- IB Diploma students cannot complete SHSM Programs in Construction or ICT
- IB Diploma and IB Certificate students **must** complete their mandatory SHSM Coop placement in the summer going into Grade 11 to fulfill this SHSM requirement
- IB Diploma students must connect their CAS Project to their SHSM area of study
- To graduate with the SHSM seal, ALL SHSM course and training components must be met while also meeting IB and OSSD Diploma requirements
- You must apply to the SHSM program
- IB Certificate students **must** meet the same SHSM course requirements as non-IB students – no exceptions
