Course selection will be done online using myBlueprint.

What do you need to graduate?

In order to obtain your Ontario Secondary School Diploma (**O.S.S.D**) you need:

18 Compulsory Credits:

- ✓ 4 credits in English (1 credit per grade)
- ✓ 3 credits in mathematics (1 credit at the senior level)
- ✓ 2 credits in science
- ✓ 1 credit in Canadian History
- ✓ 1 credit in Canadian Geography
- ✓ 1 credit in the arts
- ✓ 1 credit in health and physical education
- ✓ 1 credit in French as a second language
- ✓ .5 credit in career studies
- ✓ .5 credit in civics



What do you need to graduate?

PLUS one credit from each of the following groups:

Group 1:

Additional credit in English, or French as a second language, or other international language, or Social Sciences and the Humanities, or Canadian and World Studies, or Guidance & Career Education or Coop

Group 2:

Additional credit in Health and Physical Education, or the Arts, or Business Studies, or French as a second language or Coop

Group 3:

Additional credit in senior level science, or Technological education, or French as a second language or computer studies or Coop



Community Involvement (40 hours)



Pick up a form in Student Services, the IB Office, or visit the STA website for a form to record the details of your involvement – dates, hours completed and organization/ contact names, signatures, and phone numbers.

Alternatively, you can submit a letter from the organization (on letterhead) that outlines the details of your involvement.

Only the first 40 hours are tracked by Guidance – please keep track of hours on myBlueprint

Return all forms to the IB office.



Online Learning - 2 courses

All students in Ontario are required to complete **2 online Learning courses.** However, IB courses are **not available** online.

In the Grade 12 column of the MyBlueprint planner you can opt out of the Online Learning Requirement.

This option will ONLY be there for people who have the option - if you don't see it, you have already either completed the requirement or you opted out on paper.

Even though you see the opt out option under «courses», it does not count as a course!!



Ontario Student Transcript

- An official record of credits earned
- Grades 9 and 10
 - only successfully completed courses are recorded
 - Grades 11 and 12
 - All attempts, and the marks are recorded
 - Transcripts used for admission to Universities and Colleges

Planning Considerations

Research university/college programs and their course requirements using **myBlueprint** or **OntarioUniversitiesInfo before you choose your courses**. Every university program will have different requirements.

For example, Engineering programs usually require Physics, Chemistry, and Math, while Health Science programs require Biology, Chemistry, and Math. *All programs require English!*

You should also check the admission requirements on the University and College website. In particular, check to see if repeated/ upgrade courses are accepted.

University Admission Requirements



In Ontario you will apply via OUAC, your transcripts will be sent automatically by the school. Due date to apply is in January. You will receive more info in November.



Universities **OUTSIDE** of Ontario: it is the student's responsibility to research and apply. Be aware of application deadlines. Usually earlier than Ontario ones.



Planning to attend a university/college in the U.S? You may need to write your **SAT**s. Plan early. Find a testing facility. Some universities may not need SAT scores if you have your IB diploma. Begin your research now!

- All university programs require ENG 4U plus five (5) other U/M courses at the grade 12 level

- ✓ <u>www.ouac.on.ca</u> → you will register as an IB student (submit Ontario grades for Canadian schools)

CAS & EE

CAS (Creativity, Activity, and Service) must be **ongoing** throughout the two years of the IBDP – **Complete by March, 2026**

You should continue to engage in CAS experiences throughout the summer and record your evidence and reflections in ManageBac.

Your Extended Essay timeline and due dates are posted to ManageBac – due October 31

Keep in touch with your EE mentor as you work through this assignment!

EE integrated with ToK course - course mark is dependent on meeting EE requirements





IB Certificate Program Students
