In order to obtain your Ontario Secondary School Diploma
(**O.S.S.D**) you need:

18 Compulsory Credits:

- ✓ 4 credits in English (1 credit per grade)
- ✓ 3 credits in mathematics (1 credit at the senior level)
- ✓ 2 credits in science
- ✓ 1 credit in Canadian History
- ✓ 1 credit in Canadian Geography
- ✓ 1 credit in the arts
- ✓ 1 credit in health and physical education
- ✓ 1 credit in French as a second language
- ✓ .5 credit in career studies
- ✓ .5 credit in civics

What do you need to graduate?

PLUS one credit from each of the following groups:

Group 1:

Additional credit in English, or French as a second language, or other international language, or Social Sciences and the Humanities, or Canadian and World Studies, or Guidance & Career Education or Coop

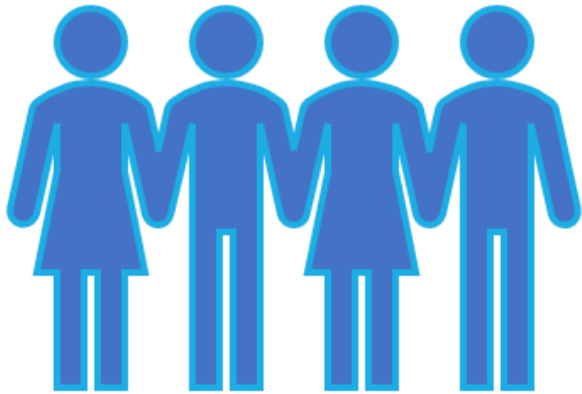
Group 2:

Additional credit in Health and Physical Education, or the Arts, or Business Studies, or French as a second language or Coop

Group 3:

Additional credit in senior level science, or Technological education, or French as a second language or computer studies or Coop

Community Involvement (40 hours)



Pick up a form in Student Services, the IB Office, or visit the STA website for a form to record the details of your involvement – dates, hours completed and organization/ contact names, signatures, and phone numbers.

Alternatively, you can submit a letter from the organization (on letterhead) that outlines the details of your involvement.

Only the first 40 hours are tracked by Guidance – please keep track of hours on myBlueprint

Return all forms to the IB office.

Online Learning - 2 courses

All students in Ontario are required to complete **2 online Learning courses**. However, IB courses are **not available** online.

In the Grade 12 column of the MyBlueprint planner you can opt out of the Online Learning Requirement.

This option will **ONLY** be there for people who have the option - if you don't see it, you have already either completed the requirement or you opted out on paper.

Even though you see the opt out option under «courses», it does not count as a course!!

Planning Considerations

Research university/college programs and their course requirements using **myBlueprint** or **OntarioUniversitiesInfo** **before you choose your courses**. Every university program will have different requirements.

For example, Engineering programs usually require Physics, Chemistry, and Math, while Health Science programs require Biology, Chemistry, and Math. *All programs require English!*

You should also check the admission requirements on the University and College website. In particular, check to see if repeated/ upgrade courses are accepted.

POST-ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- Attend a compulsory information session in July that includes ordering the required uniform and firefighting equipment
- Criminal Background Check (CBC) (no convictions with Vulnerable Sector Screening - Community partners require students to have a clear police record check for off-site placements)
- Current Canadian Heart and Stroke Foundation Basic Rescuer Certificate in CPR (Healthcare Provider)
- Current standard first aid certificate
- Entry immunization form completed by a health care provider

Please note: If you have been convicted of an offence under the criminal code for which you have not been pardoned, you may be unable to participate in off-site placements, a requirement for graduation.

In Ontario you will apply via OUAC, your transcripts will be sent automatically by the school. Due date to apply is in January. You will receive more info in November.



Universities **OUTSIDE** of Ontario: it is the student's responsibility to research and apply. Be aware of application deadlines. Usually earlier than Ontario ones.



Planning to attend a university/college in the U.S? You may need to write your **SATs**. Plan early. Find a testing facility. Some universities may not need SAT scores if you have your IB diploma. Begin your research now!

CAS & EE



CAS (Creativity, Activity, and Service) must be **ongoing** throughout the two years of the IBDP – **Complete by March, 2026**

You should continue to engage in CAS experiences throughout the summer and record your evidence and reflections in ManageBac.

Your Extended Essay timeline and due dates are posted to ManageBac – due October 31

Keep in touch with your EE mentor as you work through this assignment!

IB Certificate Program Students

- ❑ You will need to input in MyBlueprint the courses required to **finish your IB Certificates, AND religion** as well as your other selected non-IB courses.
 - ❑ IB courses and religion will take priority in scheduling over other elective courses
- ❑ IB Certificate students are **not eligible** to complete ToK, CAS or EE
- ❑ You are responsible for making sure that you have chosen what you need to complete your Certificate.

- ❑ If you wish to make changes to your program, you will need to make an appointment through Mrs. Subic.
