The **Lieutenant Governor's Community Volunteer Award for Students** has been established to honour a graduating student who achieves the highest number of community service hours and has demonstrated outstanding achievement through their volunteer efforts.

The **Lieutenant Governor's Community Volunteer Award for Students** pays tribute to students who go above and beyond the required number of volunteer hours.

Each year, an award is given to one graduating student at each of Ontario's secondary schools.

To be considered for this award, students need to submit:

- ✓ a brief summary of their volunteer activities including the name of the activity/organization, name and contact of their supervisor, date(s) of volunteering and total number of hours
- ✓ a personal reflection (200 words approx.) describing the IMPACT your volunteerism has had

NOTE: CAS hours (IB program) are not to be included

A hard copy of your application must be submitted to your Guidance Counselor by Friday May 23rd, 2025 at 1:00pm. No late applications will be accepted.
