Principal's Report October 6, 2020

School Start-up Overview:

- All staff have received safety training; staff is provided with necessary PPEs; high touch
 points are cleaned during the day and school receives deeper cleaning each evening
- Students enter/exit designated doors; use designated bathrooms; remain in classroom during the morning
- Main office, Guidance and Library restricted access; visitors have restricted access
- Currently, population is 2410 with 1053 learning exclusively from home (Cohort C)

Achieving: Meeting the needs of all learners

- Quadmester Model; blended learning; synchronous learning; academic support
- Reporting, EQAO, volunteer hours, university/college applications, etc. awaiting direction from Ministry and the Board; students should understand their progress-to-date
- Focus for learning and School Improvement Planning will be meeting to assess "most pressing student need;" understanding that needs will be different now
- Teachers continue to collaborate to share best practices for teaching with technology
- Student technology distribution significant shortage of devices; trying to source more to purchase
- Grade 8 Parent Information Night November 5 at 6:30 p.m. virtual presentation

Believing: Celebrating our Catholic faith and aspiring to be models of Christ

- Morning prayer with Mr. Dunn on YouTube channel
- Opening liturgy on Wednesday, October 7

Belonging: Embracing relationships and sustaining safe, welcoming schools

- New school name create overview describing who is St. Francis Xavier and how does his life connects with our school's vision "to accept, include and serve with love;" commission student artwork
- Will conduct an "Equity Walk" to identify needs in the school and set goals for improvement
- Tentative plan for a Student Census pilot at our school
- REDress Project art installation honouring Missing and Murdered Indigenous Women and Girls; students/staff invited to tie a piece of red ribbon or cloth to a tree to stand in solidarity with MMIWG and call for justice
- Focus on staff and student mental wellness
- Grade 9 students Class of 2024 t-shirts; arrange for Cohort C pick-up; will be connecting with Mentors (student leaders)
